ANNOUNCEMENT STEROID REFERENCE COLLECTION

The Steroid Reference Collection, which is maintained by the U.K. Medical Research Council and the U.S. National Institute of Arthritis and Metabolic Diseases, N.I.H., provides milligram or microgram samples of reference steroids free of charge for use in clinical or biochemical studies, including the development and standardization of micro-assays, chromatography, and mass spectrometry. The Collection also offers assistance with chemical problems involving steroids, and an n.m.r. service (^1H and ^{13}C) for the identification of steroids.

Recent donations of samples from eminent scientists and from the pharmaceutical industry, as well as syntheses in our laboratories, have expanded the Collection to over 4000 different compounds, including steroid hormones and their metabolites, sterols, bile acids, and commercial synthetic analogues of the steroid hormones.
